

FOUNDATION AWARDS

(Including Jane Bellamy and Elizabeth Godfrey Foundation Awards)

PURPOSE

- a) To assist women, who have completed a full time Foundation Course, at an approved tertiary institute, totalling 120 points at NCEA Level 3 or above, and have enrolled in full time study for their first degree or diploma at an approved Institute in the Auckland area, to meet course expenses. Applicants for this award must be enrolled or planning to enrol full time for a degree or diploma at the University of Auckland, the Albany Campus of Massey University, AUT University, Manukau Institute of Technology, Unitec, Whitecliffe College of Art, Laidlaw College, Northland Polytechnic, or Te Whare Wananga O Awanuiarangi, Auckland.
- b) In addition, the **Jane Bellamy and Elizabeth Godfrey** named awards are to assist two women students from the University of Auckland's Foundation Programme to study towards a degree at the University of Auckland. **Only applicants who have completed this Programme will be considered for the two named awards. Applicants for these awards must apply online to the University of Auckland.**

If you are enrolled or intending to enrol at the University of Auckland you **MUST** apply using the online application form available at <https://www.auckland.ac.nz/en/for/current-students/cs-scholarships-and-awards/cs-search-for-scholarships-and-awards.html#/form> Applications not made online will not have a successful award recorded on your University of Auckland transcript.

Applicants enrolled at other institutes in the Auckland area should apply using the following form

REGULATIONS

1. a) A number of Foundation Awards of \$1,500 shall be offered annually
b) Two Foundation Awards of \$18,000 will be available for offer annually, for candidates who have completed the University of Auckland Foundation Programme, to be paid in instalments over a six semester period
2. Applicants for a Foundation Award must be:
 - b) women;
 - c) undergraduate students studying full time for their first degree or diploma;
 - d) New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents;
3. In making these awards, the selection committee shall give consideration to:
 - a) a certified copy of the applicant's tertiary record;
 - b) a certified statement by an academic staff member who knows the applicant well;
 - c) the applicant's need for financial assistance;
 - d) the applicant's aspirations for the future;
 - e) any special circumstances e.g. family responsibilities, personal disability, considered relevant.
4. Each applicant for these awards must submit her application **on the current prescribed application form**, together with:
 - a) a certified copy or statutory declaration of her academic record, including details of the foundation course totalling 120 points that has been completed;
 - b) a certified copy of evidence of status as a New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident (not Driver Licence);
 - c) brief details of the items on which she would spend the award: for example; fees, equipment, art materials, software. NB – this does not include personal and living expenses, transport or childcare;
 - d) a brief outline of the work she hopes to do in the future;
 - e) a certified statement on the prescribed form.

5. a) The first instalment of each of the named Foundation Awards will be paid on the presentation of proof of full time enrolment in a degree course at the University of Auckland (for example, a receipted fees invoice or certification from the relevant department). Subsequent instalments will be paid at the beginning of each semester on receipt of evidence of satisfactory grades having been achieved in the previous semester. Failure to complete any semester will require a refund of that semester's payment.

b) Other Foundation Awards shall be paid in one instalment on presentation of proof of full time enrolment in a degree or diploma at one of the Institutes named above: for example, a copy of a receipted fees' invoice or certification from the relevant Department.

6. Each recipient of a Foundation Award is required to make a short written report at the end of the semester.
